Interviews aren't just an opportunity for a company to assess you - they're also your chance to learn more about the company's culture and the specific role, so you can decide if they're a correct fit for you, as well. Use these twelve questions to dig deeper during your next interview.

What does a typical day in the office look like?
What are the biggest challenges that someone in this position would face?
Is this a new role that has been created? If not, where is the last person who held this job moving on to and how long were they in the role?
Are there opportunities for advancement or professional development?
What are the most important things you'd like to see someone accomplish in the first 30, 60, and 90 days on the job? At one year?
What are the goals that the company is currently focused on and how does this team work to support meeting them?
Can you tell me about the team and who I'll be working with most closely?
Can you tell me about your particular management style?
Why did you choose to take a job at this particular company?
What's your favorite part about working here?
What's different about working here than anywhere else you've worked?
How has the company changed since you joined?
